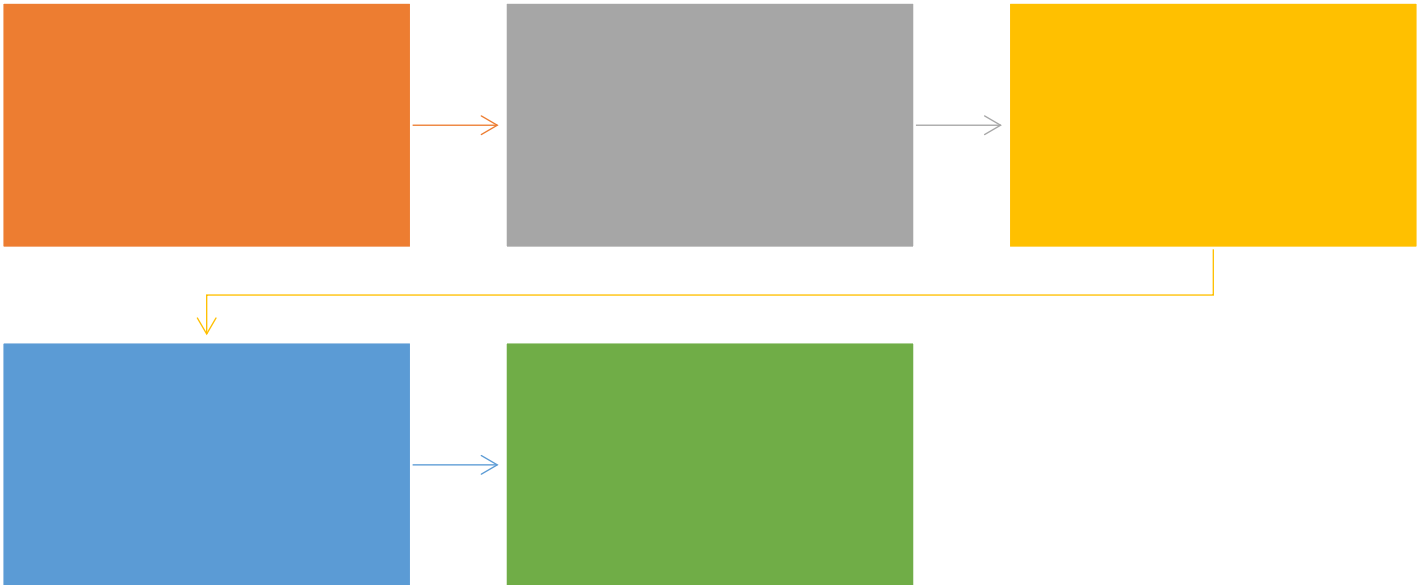




Travel Guidelines and Checklist

Tuskegee University has resumed domestic travel to activities, events, and conferences. Travel increases your chances of contracting and spreading COVID-19. Those students, faculty, and staff who are approved to travel via personal vehicle, bus, train or airplane should ensure they are in good health and follow important safety protocols listed below.



Domestic Travel Guidelines

Domestic travel is permitted at the discretion of the supervisor. Domestic student travel is permitted for academic and co-curricular purposes at the discretion of the appropriate academic or administrative department. Upon return, please follow the protocols listed below.
